GENERAL INFORMATION

<p>Registration</p>	<p>Deliver or mail your registration form and fees by June 1st. After that date, all registrations and fees should be delivered in person to Mrs. Rich, Registrar, in case classes are no longer available. CONFIRMATION OF YOUR REGISTRATION AND YOUR CLASS SCHEDULE WILL BE MAILED ON APPROXIMATELY JUNE 14, 2010.</p>

<p>Time</p>	<p>8:30 am - 12:30 pm (ESL: Time TBA)</p>
<p>Place</p>	<p>All classes will be conducted at 501 N. Beach Blvd., La Habra. All student drivers are to park their vehicles in the student parking lot. There is no parking permit fee during the summer.</p>
<p>Cost</p>	<p>To register for summer school, the registration fee and tuition in full must accompany the registration form to guarantee a spot for your student.</p> <p><u>Early registration:</u> Postmarked or received by June 1, 2010 10 credits taken: \$600 due (\$30 registration fee + \$570 tuition) 5 credits taken: \$315 due (\$30 registration fee + \$285 tuition)</p> <p><u>After June 1, 2010:</u> 10 credits taken: \$620 due (\$50 registration fee + \$570 tuition) 5 credits taken: \$335 due (\$50 registration fee + \$285 tuition)</p> <p><u>Other fees:</u> Lab fees and book fees charged where applicable</p>
<p>Refund Policy</p>	<p>The registration fee is non-refundable. <i>Tuition is non-refundable after the second day of summer school.</i></p> <p>(Only exception: If 4th quarter progress report indicates that student may need to make up a course, you may register by mail at that point; if student raised the grade making summer school unnecessary, the registration fee and tuition will be refunded.)</p>
<p>Enrollment</p>	<p>Enrollment priority is given to incoming freshmen who have already been accepted and plan to attend WCHS, and those who are currently attending WCHS. Enrollment for non-WCHS students must be individually approved by the summer school director if space is available.</p>

(General Information – continued)

Credit	Two semesters of credit can be earned during the six weeks of summer school. Original credit can be earned and will be added to the student's permanent record. Make-up classes may raise a grade already recorded, but the original grade is not removed. The higher of the two grades will be figured into the G.P.A. The student is reminded that enrollment alone does not guarantee satisfactory completion of the class.
Attendance On line attendance: Students must log in every day. Failure to log in daily will result in an absence.	No more than four days absence from any class during summer school will be allowed (<u>maximum 2 absences per 3 week period</u>). Planned absences must be pre-approved by Mr. Sanita (562-694-3803 ext. 307) Attendance will be taken in all classes. Every effort must be made to assure satisfactory attendance. No credit will be given unless attendance is satisfactory to assure successful achievement. If the student is absent more than four days within the six weeks of summer school, he/she will be dropped from the class with no credit given. This applies to all absences, both excused and unexcused. Tardies to class (including the return to class after breaks) will be recorded. Three unexcused tardies to class will constitute one absence in that class. In the event that a student is dropped from a class due to excessive absences, no refund on tuition will be made.
Conduct & Dress	Students are <u>not</u> allowed to leave campus during the morning break. All school policies which are in effect during the regular school year will be in effect during summer school. These include grooming standards, general appearance, and campus behavior.
Textbooks	There may be some workbook fees for the students, depending on the classes taken and you will be billed for them. If textbooks are used in a class which are also used in the regular school year, they will be issued to the students on a loan basis, and are to be returned at the end of summer school. All textbooks must be returned in the same condition as issued; otherwise, the student will be charged for any damage incurred.
Class Size	Classes which do not have sufficient enrollment (about 10 students) may be cancelled. In the event of class cancellation, all fees (including the registration fee) will be refunded. All summer classes have a maximum class limit and will be filled on a first come first served basis for full-time WCHS students.
